## DSA Report: Greg Dombrowski, DSA

Proud of coaches and athletes who are working hard to follow mitigation strategies. Amazing what they have accomplished. Feb 4 – Football, Cheer Fall Sports begin. Feb 15<sup>th</sup> – all other fall sports, Volleyball, Golf, Field Hockey and Cross Country. Activity registration form is going out. Live stream has been installed in gym and stadium.

Turf field money is no longer being required from the county this year. Typically \$15K.

Currently 45% of our county has had a pause in sports but we have mitigated the spread by doing so. In general FCPS coaches are doing better than other schools. Only paused for one case for each team boys basketball, football and track.

Signs requested to be put up for practices so general public is not using track during practices and meets.

County is allowing 25 spectators to home team Varsity games. 2 spectators per athlete up to a third of your capacity. 65-70 x 2 for each team and we will be collecting fees for Football and Volleyball. Max 1500 at football field. Concession sales are not allowed yet but things could change.

Awards from last year winter sports were requested for indoor track athletes. Greg and Coach Baumgartner coordinating.
