**DSA Report/Greg Dombrowski:**

- Gymnastics: Team is as large as it's ever been since Greg has started. Edison will be hosting gymnastics practice every Thursday. Additionally, Edison will host two meets.
- Meet the Coaches' Night is on Nov. 20th at 7p.
- We will be holding two varsity basketball doubleheaders with Hayfield. The first one will take place on January 9th while the second one will take place at Hayfield on February 2nd.

**Treasurer's Report/Carol Montoya:** Currently, we have \$210K in the bank. \$107K of that is allocated to teams. After paying out for football/all sports training gear and the wrestling mat, we will have \$6500 left in the improvement fund. Not all fall concessions income is booked. We will be able to allocate shares to teams and have that reflected in the November reports. Income through October is ahead of budget and expenses align with that.

- The Craft Fair netted \$5,573, which is over \$2500 ahead of budget.
- Spirit wear has netted \$2828 to date, which is over \$800 ahead of budget.
- We are \$190 short of our membership budget goal.

**VP Membership/Linda Pinkney:** 600 members as of October 27, 2023. She intends to do some marketing at the Meet the Coaches Night.
